RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Bright Red Book Bus Literacy Coaches are responsible for implementing the program, which includes:

- Engage with children and parents
- Support literacy skill development
- Stock and organize the bus daily
- Maintain all health and safety recommendations
- Drive the bus to scheduled locations
- Promote program through social media platforms

QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicants must:

- Be aged 19 and not exceed 30 years of age before or during the term of employment.
- Be available for the full term of employment.
- Have a current First Aid Certificate or be willing to obtain by start date.
- Have a valid Class 5 Driver's License & acceptable Driver's Abstract.
- Be willing to drive a larger vehicle (24 passenger bus).
- Have a satisfactory Criminal Record Check.

- An interest in children's literature and storytelling.
